SYNOPSIS

An art gallery manager, Isobel (Mireille Enos), chooses between a loving but unfulfilling relationship and the risks of the unknown. Although primarily exploring Isobel's connection to her boyfriend Peter (Rahm), "Falling Objects" looks at the changing nature of all relationships, represented by Isobel's best friend (Veronique Enos), the eerie exhibition Isobel is curating (photos by Roe Ethridge), the exhibition's artist (Hutton), and the vastness and emptiness of the landscape around Isobel, beckoning her away from a relationship that has already died.

CAMILLE THOMAN, BIOGRAPHY

After graduating with honors from the University of Bristol, UK, Camille Thoman began creating & performing a series of one-woman performance art pieces which toured the UK and were broadcast on the BBC. After a run of her show Numb at the prestigious Young Vic Theater in London, she spent a year making documentaries for Save The Children Fund in Zimbabwe. She currently works as an editor and actor in New York. Other films include 4 Stories High, and Galapagos for MTV Europe.



CAST BIOGRAPHY

Mireille Enos was nominated for a 2005 Tony for her work in *Whose Afraid of Virginia Woolf?* with Kathleen Turner and Bill Irwin. Other Broadway highlights include: Alan Ayckbourne's *Absurd Person Singular* opposite Sam Robards and Alan Ruck.

Tim Hutton won an Academy Award for Best Supporting Actor in 1980 for *Ordinary People*. Hutton has had numerous popular roles in films such as *Taps* (1981), *Beautiful Girls* (1996), *The General's Daughter* (1999), *Sunshine State* (2002), *Secret Window* (2004), *Kinsey* (2004), and the upcoming *The Good Shepard* (2006).

Melissa Leo's role as Benicio Del Toro's wife in *21 Grams* (2003) gave Leo her first exposure to a wide movie going audience. In 2005 Melissa starred opposite Tommy Lee Jones in *The Three Burials of Melquiades Estrada*. She is also well known for her long running role on Barry Levinson's *Homicide: Life on the Street*.

Kevin Rahm was a series regular on NBC's *Judging Amy* from 2003-2005. He has guest starred on *Friends*, *Joan of Arcadia* and *Grey's Anatomy*.

THE PRODUCTION

Falling Objects was shot in New York, Palm Springs, Los Angeles, The Salton Sea and Desert Center. A year was spent scouting before Thoman and cinematographer Milton Kam found the right locations. The film is set in the fictional landscape, of a desert by the ocean. Thoman was interested in the interplay between small internal performances and the vast open landscape.
